

Students from 6th form@Swakeleys have achieved some impressive results in both academic and vocational qualifications this summer! We are delighted with the results of Year 13 students who have achieved 33% A*/A, 62% A*/B and 85% A*/C grades.

We are extremely proud of the achievements of all of our students both male and female. This year, more than any other there are tremendous results across all departments with 21 subjects achieving more than 75% A* to C grades and 12 subjects achieving more than 75% A*/B grades. AS results were particularly impressive in the light of the recent changes made to the qualification. Our pass rate remained very high at 94%! 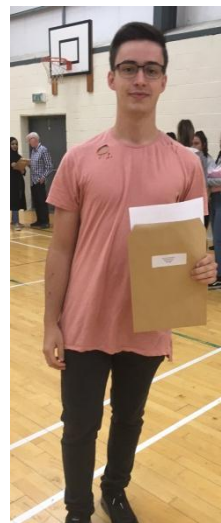
