## How does it work?

- ▶ Charville Lane West (between The Dingle and the dead end) will be made a pedestrian and cyclist only zone from **8.15am to 9.15am** and **2.30pm to 4pm** on school days only.
- ▶ A pair of signs will be erected at the entrances to the zone, warning drivers of restrictions ahead.
- ▶ Access for school staff and residents (with accesses within the restriction) will be maintained if they have registered their vehicle for an exemption.
- ▶ Special exemptions will also be granted to any blue badge holders and others, such as carers and medical staff.
- ▶ The zone is enforced by camera; non-registered vehicles entering the zone will automatically be issued with a penalty charge notice.
