1. Recruitment update

- Recruitment is going well. To date we have recruited just over 50 Trainees who will be placed in 30 schools across West London.
- We are still recruiting and plan to do so until June 2024.
- If your placement requests have changed for the programmes that you have not recruited to, *please could you notify us as soon as possible*.

2. Mentor Training for 2024-25



- Mentors are required to complete 20 hours of training, which will be funded by the DfE.
- Our mentor training curriculum focuses on our ITT curriculum and mentor skill development.
- Our plan (which has been approved by the DfE) for mentor training will consist of:
 - ½ day face to face induction conference. We will run this on 2 dates (July and September dates tbc) to so that all your mentors can attend one (synchronous delivery of 3.5 hours).
 - 6 half termly live webinars (these will take place after school) from Sept 24-June 25 (synchronous delivery of a total 6 hours).
 - Independent online learning modules (asynchronous 9 hours with deadline dates for completion).
 - Independent evidence-based reading (asynchronous 1.5 hours with deadline dates for completion).
- Please consider the above when allocating mentors to trainees that you've recruited.

3. School ITT Leads

- We will hold a virtual information session for all School ITT Leads to inform you of the changes to the ITT landscape date in **May** to be confirmed.
- During this session we will provide an overview of our Trainee and Mentor curricula.
