- Assist students in the use of equipment and materials, providing guidance and instruction as required
- Support the Design & Technology teacher in the delivery of lessons and projects
- Maintain a clean, organised and safe learning environment, ensuring equipment is stored and used appropriately
- Order and manage stock levels of materials and supplies for the Design & Technology department
- Prepare materials and equipment for lessons, projects and demonstrations

Requirements:

- Knowledge of Design & Technology principles and practices, ideally with experience of a range of machinery and equipment used in a Design & Technology classroom.
