## Information regarding Induction Day 4th September:

We are looking forward to welcoming your daughter to Swakeleys School for Girls in September. Induction Day for year 7 is Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September. Induction Day begins between 8.30 and 9am and finishes between 1.45 and 2.05pm. We have a staggered start and finish time like the taster day to reduce traffic and register year 7 efficiently. The induction day is a shorter day to ease them in after the summer holidays.

On induction day your daughter should arrive in full school uniform. Lanyards with ID cards, Link Books and timetables will be given on this day. The day includes activities which will support your daughter in getting to know the school and other members of their form and their form tutor.

There will be a staggered arrival and exit on this day to ease congestion, please see on the next page the arrival and exit times for your daughter's form:

- Staff will be waiting at the turning circle to meet your daughter and direct her to the hall. We ask that parents drop their daughters off here.
- Wear full Swakeleys school uniform.
- Bring a packed lunch as there will be no canteen or Free School Meals available until your daughter's parent pay account is set up. A packed lunch is needed for the first week.
- Bring a school bag containing a pencil case.
- PE kit is **NOT needed** on Induction Day.

If you are collecting your daughter we would appreciate that you do so **promptly** from the **drop off turning circle**. The Highfield gate will not be open on induction Day, however from Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> September it will be in use every day. We do encourage students to make their own way to and from school. Please be aware that Clifton Gardens and the front of the school can get very congested at school drop off and pick up times. Please refer to the map that you were provided with on taster day suggesting areas close to the school that can be used for drop off and pick up.

From Thursday 5th September all year 7 students must arrive to school by 8.30am and the day finishes at 3.10pm. Please be aware that the school day ends at 3.10pm every day apart from a Tuesday when the school day ends at 2.05pm.
